The petition has been filed seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to shift the petitioner under the Old Pension Scheme regime because he was entitled to *ex-gratia* benefit at the time of death of his father i.e. in December, 2002, however, the benefit was granted to him only in the year 2015.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that grievance raised herein is pending for appropriate decision before the respondents. At this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case second respondent is directed to decide the pending representation, dated 01.02.2025, Annexure P-4, in a specified period.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Krishan K. Chahal, Additional A. G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents/State and submits that the pending representation, dated 01.02.2025, will be decided by the second respondent/Director, Secondary Education, by passing a speaking/reasoned order in accordance with law within a period of three months.



5. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.

6. Ordered accordingly.

7. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioner.
