On 22.01.2025, on behalf of the appellant statement was made to accept ₹3,00,000/- over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. Today, on behalf of respondent No.2 i.e. Reliance General Insurance Company Limited, concurrence has been given to this effect. Thus, a sum of ₹3,00,000/- (₹ Three Lakh Only) is allowed to the appellant against respondent No.2 - Insurance Company.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to respondent No.2 - Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque for ₹3,00,000/- in the name of the appellant - Ashok son of Ram Kishan with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 28.03.2025, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount from the date of this order till payment. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned counsel/representative of the respondent No.2-Insurance Company. The appellant(s)' counsel/appellant(s) may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.
