This is a petition filed under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita 2023 (hereinafter referred to as 'BNSS'), for anticipatory bail in a case arising out of FIR No.8 dated 13.04.2025 under Section 21 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, Police Station ANTF, Sector 11, Chandigarh.

2. Vide order dated 22.08.2025, the petitioner was admitted to interim anticipatory bail, subject to the condition of furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Investigating Officer. It was also directed that the petitioner shall join the investigation.

3. It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that in compliance of order dated 22.08.2025, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
