The petition has been filed *inter alia* seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to grant the benefit of full pay and allowances for the period of suspension from 14.05.2009 to 06.03.2012 and all back wages with effect from 03.03.2017, along with arrears with interest at the rate of eighteen per cent from the date due till payment.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case he is permitted to file a fresh representation raising the grievance as has been raised in the instant petition, and the petition may be disposed of by directing the respondents to decide the same in a specified period.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Krishan K. Chahal, Addl. AG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents/State, and submits that in case any such representation is filed by the petitioner within a period of two weeks from today, the same will be considered and decided by respondent no.2-Direcror, Secondary Education,

by passing a speaking/reasoned order in accordance with law, within three months of receiving the representation.

5. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms of thereof.

6. Ordered accordingly.

7. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioner.
