1. The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.06 dated 21.02.2025 registered under Sections 85 & 316(2) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 at Police Station NRI, Hoshiarpur.

2. While issuing notice of motion on 25.03.2025, arrest of the petitioner was stayed and on the joint request made by learned counsel for the parties, the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court for exploring the possibility of amicable settlement between the parties.

3. As per report dated 11.09.2025 of the Mediator, the matter has been settled between the parties vide compromise deed dated 11.09.2025.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has handed over a demand draft No.412120 dated 10.10.2025 amounting to Rs.5,00,000/- in the name of respondent No.2-Sikha Devgan to learned counsel for respondent No.2 as a part payment, out of total settled amount of Rs.29,00,000/-. He has also produced copy of receipt dated 14.09.2025, whereby dowry articles have been returned to the father of respondent No.2 namely Sh. Pardeep Kumar. The same is taken on record.

5. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sohan Singh, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is not required for further investigation.

6. In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the interim relief granted to the petitioner vide order dated 25.03.2025 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) of Cr.P.C./482(2) of BNSS, 2023.
