HARSH BUNGER J. (ORAL)

Present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking quashing of the orders dated 21.05.1998 (Annexure P-9) and 21.01.1999 (Annexure P-11) passed by Superintending Canal Officer Sirhind Canal Division, Ludhiana and with a further prayer to direct the official respondents to stay the proceedings.

2. Learned counsel for respondents No.4 to 6 informs the Court that the matter has been settled between the parties and the instant petition has become infructuous.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have already sold the land in question and he has no instructions from the subsequent purchaser to pursue the present petition.

4. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for respondents No.4 to 6, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous. The petitioners or the subsequent purchaser shall be at liberty to seek revival of the present petition, in case, any grievance of their remains unaddressed.
