1. Despite case being called twice, none is present on behalf of the appellants. Perusal of file reveals that on the last date of hearing also, no one has put appearance on behalf of the appellant, it seems that appellants are not interested in pursuing the appeal.

2. Having regard to the above and considering the prevailing circumstances, the Court finds no justification to keep the appeal pending indefinitely on the docket. Despite repeated opportunities, the appellants have failed to pursue the matter. Accordingly, in the interest of expeditious disposal of cases and judicial propriety, the appeal stands dismissed for want of prosecution. Nevertheless, liberty is reserved to the appellants to seek revival of the appeal, if so advised, within a period of **three months** from today, subject to compliance with the applicable procedural requirement.
