1. Prayer in the instant civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing respondents No. 1 to 5 to take appropriate action on the complaint dated 14.04.2024 (Annexure P-1), submitted by the petitioner as regards allegation of embezzlement of Gram Panchayat funds.

2. Learned counsel for petitioner submits that the inquiry into the complaint dated 14.04.2024 (Annexure P-1) is pending before authority, however, the same has not been concluded.

3. At this stage, Mr. Navneet Singh, Senior DAG Punjab appears on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 5 and on instructions from Ms. Aman Khangura, Deputy Chief Executive Officer, Zila Parishad, Patiala (respondent No. 3 herein), submits that the inquiry into the complaint dated 14.04.2024 (Annexure P-1) is pending consideration and that the same would be concluded within a period of eight weeks from today.

4. Keeping in view the aforesaid statement made by learned State counsel, learned counsel for petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw this writ petition at this stage.
