Prayer in this petition is for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondent(s) for not complying the interim order dated 25.11.2019 (Annexure P-17) passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CRM-M-49574-2019 titled as “Harpreet Kaur and others vs. State of Punjab and others” whereby while issuing notice of motion, the operation of the impugned order dated 01.11.2019 was ordered to be stayed.

At the very outset, it is very fairly submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the main CRM-M-49574-2019 titled as “Harpreet Kaur and others vs. State of Punjab and others”, in which the aforesaid interim direction dated 25.11.2019 (Annexure P-17) was



passed, has been disposed of by the co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 08.5.2020. Learned counsel submits that in view of the same, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and the same may be disposed of as such.
