1. The present petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed by the petitioner praying for a direction to the respondents to regularize his service as per instructions dated 15.12.2006 (Annexure P-5), 22.01.2010 (Annexure P-6), 04.03.1999 (Annexure P-1) and as per the decision of this Court in CWP-24394-2011 dated 09.05.2012.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. Baltej Pal Singh Walia, Advocate appears on behalf of the respondents and waives service.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.1 to decide the legal notice dated 16.03.2025 (Annexure P-8) in a time bound manner.

5. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents submits that in view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, he has no objection if such a direction is passed.

6. In view thereof, without commenting anything upon the merits of the case, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to decide the legal notice dated 16.03.2025 (Annexure P-8), strictly in accordance with law, within a period of 8 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

7. Needless to say that respondent No.1/competent authority shall provide due opportunity of hearing to the petitioner and will pass a reasoned and speaking order while deciding the aforesaid legal notice dated 16.03.2025 (Annexure P-8).

8. Disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
