1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case FIR No.206 dated 20.12.2024, registered under Sections 380, 406 IPC at Police Station Phase 1, Mohali.
2. By virtue of order dated 14.05.2025, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join the investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated with the same and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.
4. Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner. He has submitted that the matter was referred to the Mediation Centre for settling the dispute amicably, however, due to the petitioner, the same remained unsuccessful. He further submits that gold articles have also not been recovered in this case.
5. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jaswant Singh, has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and she



is no more required for further investigation.

6. The arguments and counter arguments raised are totally a subject matter of trial. Thus, in view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 14.05.2025 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of Bharatiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.

7. Accompanying application, if any also stand disposed of.
