**ALOK JAIN, J. (Oral)**

1. The present petition is for quashing of FIR No.0265 dated 19.08.2023 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 34, 354-A, 354-D, 384, 506, 346 of IPC, registered at Police Station Rewari City, District Rewari, Haryana.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the entire allegations levelled in the FIR are false and fabricated and, in fact, the complainant was in relationship with the petitioner before her marriage as well as after her marriage. It is submitted that in fact at one point of time, compromise was also effected between the parties on 13.06.2022

(Annexure P-4) but subsequently, since the petitioner did not stop from repeatedly disturbing the matrimonial life and blackmailing the complainant of making viral her photographs and spoiling her matrimonial life, the complainant was constrained to file the FIR as when on one day, the petitioner intercepted the complainant and her husband and son in the market.

3. Learned State counsel submits that during the pendency of the present petition, the *challan* has already been presented and the investigation is complete. The petitioner would always have the right to argue all his contentions at the stage of framing of charge.

4. Heard the learned counsel for the parties.

5. In light of the above coupled with the fact that since there are disputed questions of facts which need to be taken care of by the strength of evidence, it is not a fit case where the powers under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. (528 of BNS, 2023) need not be exercised, as there are serious allegations against the petitioner.

6. Finding no merit, the present petition is dismissed.

7. Pending miscellaneous application(s) shall stand disposed of.
