The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for seeking directions to official respondents to add the offence under Section 118(2) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 in FIR bearing No.115 dated 19.08.2025 registered under Sections 118(1), 115(2) and 3(5) and Section 333 (added vide Rapat No.027 dated 19.08.2025) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 at Police Station Bahawala, District Fazilka.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that six accused entered into the house of the petitioners and attacked them. Initially due to political pressure, offence under Section 333 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita had not been added but the same was incorporated vide Rapat No.027 dated 19.08.2025. He contends that notwithstanding that AIIMS, Bathinda has declared the injuries to be grievous, however, offence under Section 118(2) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 so far has not been added. The present petition has thus been filed before this Court.

3. In view of the above, I am of the opinion that the present petition is premature at this stage. The case is still at initial stage of investigation and all such material and MLR report furnished by the doctors shall be taken into consideration by the authorities. Such micro-level management of the investigation and the offences that may be attracted to, is not required to be dealt by the High Court at the initial stage of investigation. Besides this, the petitioners would not be remediless as the offences in question can always be looked into by the competent Court as and when a final report is filed. The present petition has seemingly been filed only to exert pressure on the investigating agency and to steer investigation in the manner as desired by the petitioners.

4. Finding that the present petition has entirely been filed only to exert pressure on the investigating agency and to steer investigation, the present petition is dismissed.
