Petition herein is for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the letter dated 31.05.2024 (Annexure P7) and letter dated 27.09.2013 (Annexure P5) vide which the petitioner has been found not eligible for allotment of plot under R & R Policy (Annexure P4) with further prayer for issuance of writ of mandamus directing the respondents to allot a plot of 4 marla to the petitioner under Oustees Quota.

2. Considering the nature of relief sought in the present writ petition, we deem it appropriate to dispose of the present writ petition by giving liberty to the petitioner to move an appropriate representation regarding the relief sought in the present writ petition before respondent No.3 i.e. Estate Officer, Haryana State Industrial & Infrastructure Development Corporation Ltd., IMT Manesar, District Gurugram.

3. Without commenting on merits of the case, the petition is disposed of. In case, any such representation has been made by the petitioner, the same shall be decided by respondent No.3, in accordance with law, preferably within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of copy/ production of this order, if required respondent No.3 shall give a personal hearing to the petitioners..

4. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
