The petition has been filed *inter alia* seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to grant benefits of notional pay fixation and seniority to the petitioners by fixing their pay at par with the candidates who are lower in merit and given joining with effect from 30.11.2018.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that grievance raised herein is pending for appropriate decision before the respondents. At this stage, the petitioners will be satisfied in case respondent no.2 is directed to decide their pending legal notice, dated 13.11.2024, Annexure P-7, in a specified period.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Tanushree Gupta, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents, and submits that the pending legal notice, dated 13.11.2024, will be decided by respondent no.2-Director Secondary School Education Department, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within three months.



5. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioners has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.

6. Ordered accordingly.

7. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioners.
