ANOOP CHITKARA, J. (ORAL)

The present petition has been filed under Section 482 BNSS, 2023 read with Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 for seeking Blanket Anticipatory bail with a further prayer for issuance of directions to respondents to serve 15 days prior notice to the petitioner.

2. To substantiate his submissions, he has cited a judgment passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in ***Sukhdev Singh Versus State of Punjab and others, CRM-M-31442-2021, decided on 12.10.2021.***

3. A perusal of the aforesaid judgment clearly reflects that in that case the relief was granted in a specific context as allegation was against police official for pressurising to pay Rs.1,90,000/-, as such, co-ordinate Bench of this Court directed that if any FIR is registered for an amount of Rs.1,90,000/- to be recovered from the petitioner (Sukhdev Singh), in that case, seven days advance notice would be given. Thus, on the facts and law, the said judicial precedents does not apply to the case of petitioner. The law is settled that a blanket bail cannot be granted, as such, present petition is liable to be dismissed.

4. At this stage, counsel for the petitioner submits that he be permitted to make a representation to the concerned Senior Superintendent of Police.



5. Given above, the present petition is dismissed with clarification that in case, the petitioner files a representation to the concerned Senior Superintendent of Police within a week from today i.e. by 10.05.2025, then the same shall be decided by the concerned Senior Superintendent of Police on or before 25.05.2025 either himself or by authorizing and delegating it to any officer holding IPS cadre. It is clarified that such order must be a reasoned order, and the same be communicated to the representationists without delay. All pending miscellaneous applications, if any, stand disposed of.
