1. This petition has been filed under Section 528 BNSS, 2023 for issuance of directions to the official respondents for conducting fair and impartial investigation and to take action against respondents No. 4 and 5.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has preferred a complaint dated 26.12.2024 (Annexure P-2) to respondent No.2- Deputy Commissioner, Chandigarh but no action has been taken so far. Learned counsel submits that he would be satisfied if directions are issued to respondent No.2- Deputy Commissioner, Chandigarh to look into his complaint and take appropriate steps at the earliest.
3. Notice of motion to the official respondents only.
4. At the asking of the Court, Mr. Sumit Jain, APP, U.T., Chandigarh accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.
5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and the limited prayer made by the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Deputy Commissioner, Chandigarh to consider and decide the complaint dated 26.12.2024 (Annexure P-2) of the petitioner in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
