1. Report of Warrant Officer dated 26.06.2025 received. As per said report, statement of petitioner Krishna Nandan (Annexure W-3) recorded. As per said statement, petitioner visited police station alongwith Warrant Officer where detenu Dev met in the office of SHO, Police Station Division No. 6, Ludhiana, who was present alongwith his counsel Sh.
