the parties is genuine and without any pressure. A copy of Receipt of costs of Rs. 7500/- has been placed on record in compliance of the order dated 09.12.2024.

3. Learned counsel for respondent No.2 does not oppose the compromise having been effected between the parties.

4. In view of the report of the learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Kharar, and in view of the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in "*Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another*", 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and "*Narinder Singh and Others Vs. State of Punjab and Another*", (2014) 6 SCC 466, this Court is of the opinion that no useful purpose can be served by keeping the criminal proceedings pending, since the respondents have themselves compromised the dispute with the petitioners/ accused persons.

5. In the circumstances, the present petition is allowed. FIR No.06 20.01.2022 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections Sections 379, 427 of IPC and 411 and 201 of IPC have been added later on at P.S. Sadar Kurali, District SAS Nagar, and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise qua the present petitioners.
