1. The applications preferred by the petitioner, regarding incentive amount of Rs.2,50,000/- under Mukhya Mantri Samajik Samrasta Antarjatiya Vivah Shagun Yojana, have not been decided by the authorities concerned, which has caused grievance to the petitioner, and propelled him to file the instant writ petition, cast under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking a mandamus to respondents, to decide his applications/representations dated 03.03.2025 (Annexures P-1 and P-2).
2. Notice of motion.
3. Mr. Bhupender Singh, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents, and waives service. He submits that he has no objection, in case, a mandamus is passed upon the respondents No.3 and 4, to decide the applications/representations (supra), in a time bound manner.
4. In view of the consensus arrived at between the parties, this Court, deems it apt to dispose of the instant writ petition, with a mandamus



upon the respondents No.3 and 4, to decide the applications/representations (supra), within a period of 30 days, from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

5. Mr. Bhupender Singh, DAG, Haryana, also undertakes to intimate the respondents No.3 and 4, about passing of this order, with a further direction to make compliance thereof.

6. Consequently, the instant writ petition is **disposed of**.
