1. Petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of BNSS Act of 2023, seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 232 dated 07.09.2024, under Sections 109/304/118/115(2)/191(3)/190 of BNS Act, 2023 and Sections 25/27 of Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Jandiala, Amritsar.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the grave offence in the present case is Section 109 of BNS Act, 2023 and there is compromise between all the accused and both the injured.
3. Learned State counsel on instructions informs the Court that petitioner is already an accused in eight other criminal cases and number of cases are registered against the co-accused.
4. In view of the above, this Court does not find any substantial reason to entertain the present petition granting anticipatory bail to the petitioner and the same is hereby dismissed.
5. However, it would be open for the petitioner to move a regular bail petition before the concerned Court by relying upon the compromise,

wherein the Court concerned would examine all the facts and circumstances including the nature of the offence.
