Prayer in the present writ petition, filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia*, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing respondent No.2 to correct the petitioner's date of birth in her passport as per the documents submitted by the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has handed over a copy of letter dated 19.02.2025 issued by the Regional Passport Office, Chandigarh to the petitioner, whereby the petitioner has been called to their office on 24.04.2025 with all the original documents. The same is taken on record, subject to all just exceptions.

3. At this stage, learned counsel for respondents No.1 and 2 submits that the application for re-issuance of passport, submitted by the petitioner is under active consideration by the Passport Authorities and in case, the petitioner appears before the Regional Passport Office, Chandigarh along with all the original documents as sought by the Regional Passport Office, Chandigarh, in the aforesaid letter dated 19.02.2025, the final decision shall be taken thereon, within a period of six weeks from the date such documents are provided by the petitioner.

4. Keeping in view the aforesaid submissions made by learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition is accordingly disposed of.

5. All pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
