1. This Appeal arises out of an interim order dated 30.07.2024 passed by the learned Single Bench in CWP-17231-2024 filed by respondents No.13 to 107.

2. An application seeking vacation of the stay has already been filed. The grievance of the appellant is that the application for stay vacation has not been considered by the learned Single Bench so far, and the interim order continues to remain in force.

3. The argument has also been raised by the learned counsel for the respondents No.13 to 107 with regard to the maintainability of this Appeal since alternative remedy had not been availed by the appellant.

4. Be that as it may, considering the fact that the said application for vacation of stay is pending and the next date in the matter is 27.08.2025, before the learned Single Bench, we are not inclined to interfere with the said interim order passed by the learned Single Bench.

5. In such view of the matter, we ***dispose of*** this appeal with a request to the learned Single Bench to take up the said application, seeking vacation of stay of the impugned order, filed by the appellant, and dispose it off as per earliest convenience of learned Single Bench in accordance with law, leaving all questions open to address.

6. All pending applications, if any, in this case are dismissed of accordingly.
