1. Present petition has been filed seeking direction to respondent No.2 to look into the request of the petitioner dated 16.12.2024 and to proceed with the same as respondent No.3 has failed to take any action against respondents No.4 to 8 as they have interfered in the peaceful possession of the petitioner and gave injuries to his family members and further they be directed to not unnecessarily harass the petitioner and his family members and threatening them to withdraw the complaint against respondents No.4 to 8.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the redressal of his grievance, petitioner has filed a request/application dated 16.12.2024 (Annexure P-7) before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar but the same has not been taken into consideration till date. He has further submitted that petitioner would be satisfied if request/application dated 16.12.2024 (Annexure P-7) is decided in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Tarun Aggarwal, Sr. D.A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.



5. After hearing counsel for the parties, respondent No.2- the Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar is directed to decide the request/application dated 16.12.2024 (Annexure P-7) filed by the petitioner expeditiously preferably within one month from today, in accordance with law.

6. In view of the above, present petition is disposed of.
