MANDEEP PANNU J.

1. The present revision petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for setting aside the order dated 14.07.2025 (Annexure P-1) passed by the learned Additional District Judge, Patiala.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that by the impugned order, the application seeking interim relief by way of stay of the execution proceedings has been dismissed arbitrarily and illegally, without considering the legal issues involved.
3. A perusal of the impugned order (Annexure P-1), however, makes it evident that the same does not pertain to dismissal of any such application for interim stay. The impugned order merely records the dismissal of the petitioner's request for preponing the date fixed for consideration of the stay application in the execution proceedings. The stay application itself remains pending before the Court below and has not yet been adjudicated.
4. It is not in dispute that the next date in the execution proceedings is 18.08.2025. Therefore, the present revision petition is directed against an order

which neither decides nor affects the merits of the petitioner's stay application. Such a challenge, being premature and against a non-existent grievance, is not maintainable.

5. In view of the above, there is no ground for interference under Article 227 of the Constitution of India. The revision petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
