1. The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.13 dated 17.01.2025 registered under Section 64 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 at Police Station Jandiala, District Amrtisar.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 01.04.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.
