1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondent to refix his pay and grant notional benefits as granted to similarly situated Constable Jarnail Singh.

2. The petitioner claims that his deemed date of joining and of Jarnail Singh is 07.11.2011. The respondent in the case of Jarnail Singh vide order dated 16.02.2021 has considered 07.11.2011 his deemed date of joining. The petitioner has been differently treated.

3. Mr. Kapila submits that grievance of petitioner at this stage would be redressed if respondents are directed to consider his claim in the light of order dated 16.02.2021 passed by Commissioner of Police, Amritsar in the case of similarly situated Constable Jarnail Singh.

4. Mr. Aman Dhir, DAG, Punjab, who on advance notice is present in Court, assures the Court that competent authority would look into the matter and pass an appropriate order within 3 months from today.

5. Mr. Kapila agrees to the aforesaid arrangement.

6. In the wake of statement of both sides, instant petition stands disposed of. It is made clear that if arrears arise at any stage, would not carry interest.
