1. Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of directions to respondent Nos. 1 and 2 for issuance and release of new passports to the petitioners-minors on the basis of sole consent of their mother, as per form 'Annexure C' (Annexure P-5) and without taking the consent of the father as the mother of the petitioners is unable to obtain the consent of the father on account of the fact that the father of the petitioners is living in Portugal and his whereabouts are not known to the mother of the petitioners.

2. On advance notice, Ms. Amrita Singh, Standing counsel for the respondent-Union of India puts in appearance and submits that petitioners have not supplied 'Annexure C'. She further submits that in case the petitioners supply Annexure 'C', their case will be dealt with, in accordance with law.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have submitted their application (Annexure P-4) for issuance of their new passports along with all the requisite documents including form 'Annexure C'. He further submits that the petitioners are ready and willing to supply the copy of application



(Annexure P-4) along with Annexure 'C' by approaching the office of Passport Authorities.

6. In view of the statement of learned counsel for the respondent-Union of India, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
7. Pending application (s), if any, also stand disposed of.
