**JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (ORAL)**

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking regularisation as per Policy of 1993.
2. Mr. Raman Sharma, Addl. A.G.Haryana submits that petitioner was regularised as per Policy of 2003. He was initially appointed as temporary employee and paid from contingent fund. He worked from September'1987 to February'1989 and thereafter from March'1989 to March'1993 as a whole time contingent paid Syce. He was appointed with effect from 29.11.1994 as a Cook and continued to work as such till 2003 and thereafter he was regularised as a Cook.
3. As the petitioner stands regularised as per Policy of 2003; he was not appointed against a sanctioned post or through a regular process and



in view of judgment of Supreme Court in **Secretary, State of Karnataka & Others. vs. Umadevi & Others, (2006) 4 SCC 1**, the petitioner cannot claim regularisation as per Policy of 1993, the petition stands disposed of. The petitioner is at liberty to move an appropriate application within three months from today, if cause survives.
