[2] By referring to the aforesaid affidavit dated 07.02.2025, learned counsel for the respondents submits that the Hon'ble Supreme Court, vide order dated 03.01.2025 (Annexure R-1) passed in *Special Leave Petition (Civil) Diary No. 56458 of 2024*, titled "*State of Haryana and others Versus Saffik*", arising out of the final order dated 29.05.2024 passed by the Hon'ble Division Bench of this Court in an intra-Court appeal bearing *LPA No. 770 of 2020*, titled "*State of Haryana and others Versus Saffik*", ordered that the operation of judgment dated 29.05.2024 shall remain stayed.
