Present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking issuance of directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to take appropriate action on the representation dated 13.02.2025 (Annexure P-2) submitted by the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that petitioner and her mother have purchased a plot measuring 01 kanal 1.25 marlas on 08.02.2025 and the same plot was purchased through Pardeep Jain/respondent No. 7, who is relative of the petitioner from one Jagpal Singh/respondent No. 4. Learned counsel further contends that there was no land left with the seller and they have carved out a residential colony and the land which was left vacant for street, has been sold to the present petitioner. Learned counsel further submits that petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 12.03.2025 (Annexure P-2) to respondent No. 2 with regard to fraud committed by private respondents, but no action has been taken on it so far.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2

to consider and decide the representation dated 12.03.2025 (Annexure P-2) submitted by the petitioner in a time bound manner.

Keeping in view the prayer made by the petitioner and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 to consider and decide the representation dated 12.03.2025 (Annexure P-2) submitted by the petitioner and take appropriate steps in view of the submissions made therein, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
