RAJESH BHARDWAJ, J. (ORAL)

1. Present petition has been filed praying for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.143, dated 04.09.2024, under Sections 111(3), 111(2) of BNS and Sections 25, 54, 59, 25(7) of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Division-B, District Amritsar.
2. Vide order dated 07.07.2025, while granting the interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join the investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 07.07.2025, the petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.



4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Avtar Singh Pairvi appeared for Insp. Barjinder Singh, has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

5. In view of the above, interim order dated 07.07.2025 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS, 2023.
