1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits vide order dated 11.01.2024 (Annexure P-2) passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CWP-514-2024 titled as 'Gurbaksh Singh vs. State of Punjab and others', it has been directed as under:-

“After hearing learned counsel for the parties and perusing the record, respondent No. 4 i.e. District Development & Panchayat Officer, Jalandhar is directed to decide the legal notice dated 30.10.2023 (Annexure P-7) served by the petitioner expeditiously preferably within a period of four weeks from today in accordance with law.”



2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the respondent submits that in pursuance to the aforesaid order dated 11.01.2024 (Annexure P-2), speaking order dated 05.03.2024 (Annexure R-1/T) has been passed upon the legal notice dated 30.10.2023 (Annexure P-1) served by the petitioner. Thus, it is submitted that the order dated 11.01.2024 (Annexure P-2) stands duly complied with and nothing survives in the present petition.

3. In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition, the same stands **disposed of**, accordingly.

4. The petitioner would be at liberty to challenge the aforesaid speaking order, in accordance with law.

5. Rule stands discharged.

6. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
