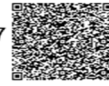

AMARJOT BHATTI, J.

1. Petitioner has filed instant petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.18 dated 01.02.2025 under Sections 85/316 (2) Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 registered at Police Station Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur (Annexure P-1).

2. As per facts of the case, complainant Monika Rani filed written complaint against her husband Kamaljit Singh and other members of in-laws family alleging that their marriage was performed on 26.03.2023. Her parents had given gold ornaments, household articles and electrical appliances as detailed in the FIR. They had spent about Rs.5 lacs on her marriage. After marriage, her husband started taunting her that her parents did not give a motorcycle in marriage. He complained for not giving gold

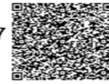


ornaments to the other members of family. She was continuously harassed in the matrimonial home. She suffered medical problem and entire expenses were borne by her parents. She was advised rest for three months. Nobody came to know about her welfare. She was taken back in the matrimonial home and on 19.10.2024 she was again sent back to her parental house. False allegations were levelled against her and her family members. Matter also came before Panchayat but it could not be resolved. Finally, the complaint was filed on the basis of which present FIR has been registered.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner argued that he was granted interim relief vide order dated 10.07.2025 and in pursuance of this, he has already joined the investigation and all dowry articles are already handed over to the police which are taken into their possession. He is still ready to abide by the terms of bail order.

4. Status report filed confirming the facts narrated in the FIR. Today, learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Baljinder Singh, SHO Dasuya, submits that petitioner joined the investigation and handed over the dowry articles which are taken into police possession vide recovery memo dated 19.08.2025. It is stated that he is not required for further investigation.

5. Considering the aforesaid factual position, anticipatory bail petition filed by petitioner is allowed. He be not arrested. In case of his arrest, he be released on bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer concerned, subject to condition that petitioner will join investigation as and when required. He will not tamper with or interfere with investigation and will not leave country without prior permission as provided under Section 482 (2) of BNSS, 2023.



6. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
