1. The petitioners are seeking the concession of anticipatory bail, under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023, in case FIR No.44, dated 21.05.2025, under Sections 115(2), 333, 191(3), 190 of BNS, 2023, registered at Police Station Hajipur, District Hoshiarpur.

2. On the previous date of hearing i.e.17.06.2025, while noticing the following submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioners, a coordinate Bench of this Court had granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioners and asked them to join investigation:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners *inter alia* submits that the FIR in question (Annexure P-2) was registered as a counter-blast to the FIR (Annexure P-1), in which the victim was the niece of petitioner No.1 (Rana). He submits that even as per the medico legal report, two injuries alleged to have been caused by a blunt weapon have been noted. Learned counsel further submits that though two other cases are registered against petitioner No.1, the same are in no manner related to the present case and even otherwise, he is on bail in

the said cases. He further submits that the petitioners are willing to join investigation and abide by any condition imposed by this Court.”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of order dated 17.06.2025, the petitioners have joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions, does not dispute the factum of the petitioners having joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. He, on further instructions, submits that the petitioners are not required for further investigation much less for their custodial interrogation.

5. In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 17.06.2025, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C./482(2) of BNSS, 2023.
