The present contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of order dated 20.12.2017, vide which, a direction was issued to the petitioner to send a fresh copy of the legal notice/representation to the concerned authority alongwith a copy of order by registered/speed post and thereafter, the respondents were directed to decide the same within six weeks.

Mr. Aditya Sharda, AAG, Punjab, who is present in Court has pointed out from the advance copy of the petition received by him that the petitioner does not seem to have sent any fresh legal notice/representation.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner has pointed out from the petition that copy of the order was sent to respondent No.5 on 25.01.2018. However, neither copy of the alleged fresh legal notice/representation has been placed on record nor even the date of the fresh legal notice is mentioned in the contempt petition nor any postal receipts of any such order or legal notice sent in terms of order dated 20.12.2017 passed by this Court has been placed on record.

In view of the same, the present contempt petition is dismissed with liberty to file the fresh legal notice/representation in the same terms of order dated 20.12.2017 passed by this Court.
