Present petition has been filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India and under Section 528 of BNSS 2023 seeking protection of life and liberty of the petitioner from respondents No. 5 to 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that petitioner and respondent No. 5 got married on 01.02.2024 as per Sikh rites and rituals and the marriage certificate is annexed as Annexure P-2. After marriage, petitioner came to know that respondent No. 5 is also in parallel relationship with some other person. When the petitioner told family members of respondent No. 5 about her relationship, her family members i.e. respondents No. 6 and 7, in spite of helping the petitioner, started threatening the petitioner to stay away from respondent No. 5. Thereafter, respondents No. 5 to 7 are threatening to kill and extort the petitioner by making extortion calls, *recee* and stalking the petitioner and his family members with dire consequences. Petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 29.10.2024 (Annexure P-5) in this regard, but no action has been taken on it so far.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation dated 29.10.2024 (Annexure P-5) submitted by the petitioner in a time bound manner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to supply a copy of complete paper book to learned State counsel today itself.

Keeping in view the prayer made by the petitioner and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 to consider and decide the representation dated 29.10.2024 (Annexure P-5) submitted by the petitioner and take appropriate steps in view of the submissions made therein, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
