1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.31, dated 19.01.2024, registered under Sections 365, 368, 120-B IPC, at Police Station Sadar Ballabgarh, District Faridabad.

2. Vide order dated 29.07.2025, the petitioner was granted interim bail and was directed to join investigation.

3. Status report has been filed by learned State counsel and the same is taken on record. Learned State counsel on instructions from the Investigating Officer, has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation on 01.08.2025 and now his custodial interrogation is not required.

4. Therefore, keeping in view the nature of the allegations, pre-trial incarceration of the petitioner is not required. As such, a case is

made out for allowing the present petition. Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 29.07.2025, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 482(2) of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023 (analogous to Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure).
