1. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits, that in respect of the disputed lands, proceedings under Section 167 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), became launched, and were terminated through a passing of an order Annexure P-1. Moreover, he also submits that since Annexure P-1 has been challenged through a revision thereagainst being filed before the revisional authority. Consequently, in the face of above, since the disputed lands are under litigation amongst the various rival claimants, who have claimed valid possession thereovers.

2. Consequently, till the Courts concerned clinch the supra controversy thereuptos, this Court does not deem it fit and appropriate to make a mandamus upon the respondents concerned, to subject the disputed lands to any public auction. However, the disputes appertaining to the rival claimants who are asserting possession over the disputed lands, be ensured to be expeditiously settled within three months from today.

3. Disposed of accordingly, alongwith all pending applications, if any.
