Challenge is to the order dated 22.10.2024 passed by Civil Judge (Junior Division), Rewari whereby an application filed by the petitioner to stall the execution of the preliminary decree claiming that the same has been obtained by concealing and suppressing the material facts, stands declined.

2. Counsel for the petitioner does not dispute that even though the petitioner was party to the suit and suffered preliminary decree however, no appeal was preferred against the same claiming that the same is result of concealment of material facts.

3. In view thereof, this Court does not find any reason to interfere in a well reasoned order passed by the Trial Court. Finding no merit in the present revision petition, the same is ordered to be dismissed.
