**FAO-4369-2022**

**AWARD OF LOK ADALAT BENCH NO.5**

The appeal stands settled at Rs.75,000/- (Rupees Seventy Five Thousand Only) and above the amount already awarded by the learned Tribunal in terms of the proposal duly signed by both the parties today.

Accordingly, this award is made with the direction to the Insurance Company to deposit the enhanced amount of Rs.75,000/- (Rupees Seventy Five Thousand Only) by cheque/draft, in favour of appellant-Rohit Chhabra with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within a period of 6 weeks of this order. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellant counsel may collect the cheque/draft from the office of the Lok Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopies of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the Counsel.

At this stage, learned counsel for the Insurance Company states that today he is not carrying the complete record of the case. Therefore, he want that the payment should be made subject to the confirmation of the Insurance Policy of the vehicle in question and other relevant documents.

Appeal stands disposed of in terms of the settlement.
