The petitioner/L.D.C. (Retd.) through his attorney/wife-Smt. Sumeet Kaur had filed CWP No.5306 of 2016, seeking directions to the respondents to complete his Service-Book and after re-fixing his pay, release the retiral benefits etc. along with interest. The said petition was disposed of by this Court vide order dated 21.03.2016 (**Annexure P-1**), with a direction to the Chief Engineer, Distribution, Central Zone, PSPCL (respondent herein) to dispose of the Legal Notice dated 22.12.2015 served by the petitioner expeditiously, preferably within two months from the receipt of certified copy of the order. Since the needful was not done within the stipulated time, hence the present contempt petition.

Upon notice, reply has been filed, wherein it is submitted that the claim set up in the Legal Notice dated 22.12.2015 has been considered and decided by passing a speaking order dated 05.12.2016 (**Annexure R-1**).

Learned Counsel for the respondent submits that the present petition has become infructuous as the directions passed by this Court stand complied with.

In view of the above, no further action is warranted.

Accordingly, the present contempt petition stands dismissed as infructuous.

The petitioner is free to challenge the aforesaid speaking order in accordance with law.
