By way of the present writ petition, the petitioner has sought issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to hand over the physical possession of the Commercial Booth/building No.18, 19, 20, 21 and Residential Plot No.3 in Sector 24-25A, Urban Estate, Gurugram II, after completion of development works/basic amenities, including road, street light, Sewerage, Parking etc.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that with regard to her grievance, the petitioner has already made representations dated 10.12.2024 and 01.02.2025 (Annexures

P-11 and P-12 respectively), followed by reminder dated 05.02.2025 (Annexure P-13) to the competent authority, but no action has been taken thereon till date.

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent Nos. 2 and 3-HSVP, submits that the said representations shall be considered and decided by the competent authority, in accordance with law.

4. Without commenting on merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Estate Officer II, HSVP, Gurugram (competent authority), to look into the pending representations/reminder dated 10.12.2024, 01.02.2025 and 05.02.2025 (Annexures P-11 to P-13 respectively) of the petitioner and pass an appropriate reasoned order thereon, in accordance with law, preferably within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of copy/production of this order.

5. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
