1. Present petition has been filed praying for directing respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the lives and personal liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 to 8 and not to allow respondents No.4 to 8 or anybody else to interfere in the liberty and lives of petitioners or to harass them in any manner against the wishes of the petitioners or to cause any detriment to the petitioners in any manner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that both the petitioners are major and have married against the wishes of respondents No.4 to 8 and have sought protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger from respondents No.4 to 8. Their marriage certificate evidencing their marriage is on record as Annexures P-3. The



petitioners have submitted a representation dated 08.10.2025 (Annexure P-4) to respondent No.2.

3. Notice of motion to official respondents No.1 to 3-State only.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. J. S. Arora, DAG, Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3-State.

5. Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, I dispose of the petition with a direction to respondent No.2, i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Sri Muktsar Sahib to decide the representation dated 08.10.2025 (Annexure P-4) of the petitioners and grant them protection, if any threat to their life and liberty is perceived. It is clarified that this order shall not be taken to grant immunity to the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them. This order would not be understood having expressed any opinion whatsoever by this Court on the validity of the marriage of the petitioners.

6. Disposed of.
