JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to issue him appointment letter under Scheduled Caste category for the post of Senior Accounts Clerk.

2. The petitioner pursuant to Advertisement No.14/2019 (Category No.12) applied for the post of Senior Accounts Clerk. His name appeared in the waiting list dated 22.03.2022.

3. The petitioner claims that two selected candidates have resigned, thus, he is entitled to be considered because his name had figured in waiting list.

4. Ms. Rajni Gupta, Addl. A.G., Haryana, who on advance notice is present in Court, submits that waiting list remains in force for one year from the date of declaration of result. Nevertheless, the case of petitioner would be considered if candidates have resigned during the lifetime of the waiting list. The



respondent would pass an appropriate order considering the date of resignation of selected candidates and merit of the petitioner in the waiting list.

5. Mr. P.K. Ganga agrees to the aforesaid arrangement.

6. In the wake of statement of both sides, instant petition is disposed of.
