**JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J (ORAL)**

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of orders dated 31.05.2021 (Annexure P-6) and 17.06.2021 (Annexure P-7) whereby his claim for reimbursement of medical expenses to the tune of Rs. 1,28,052/- has been declined.

2. Mr. Pankaj Maini, Advocate submits that vide instructions dated 20.11.2017 (Annexure P-9) and subsequent instructions, the income criteria has been abolished. The claim of petitioner was declined on account of income criteria, thus, matter needs to be re-examined.

3. Ms. Dimple Jain, DAG, Haryana does not oppose the said prayer and submits that Competent Authority within 3 months from today would consider claim of the petitioner.

4. Counsel for petitioner agrees to the aforesaid arrangement.

5. In the wake of statement of both sides, the present petition stands disposed of.
