**HARKESH MANUJA, J. (Oral)**

1. Learned State counsel relies upon a communication dated 10.03.2025 issued by the Secretary, Haryana Staff Selection Commission, Panchkula and on instructions from Ms. Kamalpreet Kaur, Asstt. Director, Elementary Education Haryana, submits that name of the petitioner has been recommended for the post of TGT Science and necessary formalities in relation to his joining shall be concluded within four weeks from today.
2. In view of the aforesaid undertaking by the respondent(s), learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition.
3. Dismissed as not pressed. Rule stands discharged.

However, in case the needful is not done within the aforementioned period, as per the undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring/concerned officer would be liable to pay a sum of Rs.50,000/- as cost(s) from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
