Prayer in this revision petition is for setting aside/quashing of order dated 29.11.2024 (Annexure P-17) passed by learned Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Phillaur in CM-48/2019 in Civil Suit No.479 of 2018 instituted on 25.7.2018 titled as "Dharampal vs. Balwinder Kumar etc. vide which learned Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.) Phillaur had allowed the application dated 12.9.2024 (Annexure P-15) for amendment of application under Order 39 Rule 2-A CPC (Annexure P-6) moved by respondent No.1 which was filed in counter to the order dated 09.9.2024 (Annexure P-13) passed by co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CR-4092-2023 titled as "Dharam Pal vs. Balwinder Kumar and others" whereby the revision petition filed by respondent No.1 was dismissed by upholding the order dated



21.4.2023 (Annexure P-12) passed by the Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), vide which the application for amendment of the plaint was dismissed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner informs on instructions that the main civil suit filed by the respondent(s) stands dismissed on merits by the learned Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.) vide judgment and decree dated 22.4.2025. It is accordingly submitted that nothing survives in the present petition as the impugned order has merged in the decree passed by the learned trial Court; and therefore learned counsel prays that in view of the said facts, the present petition may be disposed of.
