Learned counsel for the applicant-respondent submits that as the dispute between the parties has been amicably resolved, nothing substantive survives in the present appeal. He further submits that a formal compromise, dated October 16, 2024, was entered into between the parties, and pursuant thereto, the appellant(s) has since remitted Rs.70 lakh to the applicant-respondent. As a result, the execution petition has also been withdrawn by the decree-holder.

Learned counsel for the appellants does not dispute the factual position indicated above.

With the consent of learned counsel for the parties, the date fixed in the appeal is preponed from 25.02.2025 to today, i.e. 07.02.2025.

Accordingly, CM-5-RFCOM-2025 is allowed, and the appeal is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
