1. The petitioner is seeking the concession of anticipatory bail under Section 482 of the Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in case FIR No.106, dated 11.03.2025, under Section 209 of BNS, 2023, registered at Police Station Meham, District Rohtak.

2. At the outset when a query was put to learned counsel for the petitioner as to how the petitioner, who admittedly is a proclaimed person, could be extended the concession of anticipatory bail, he submitted that the matter stood compromised between the parties.

3. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the instant petition and instead submits that he would avail of alternative remedies by approaching the trial Court concerned.

4. Dismissed as not pressed.
